- Is always a recommendation that all projects have an up to date web presence

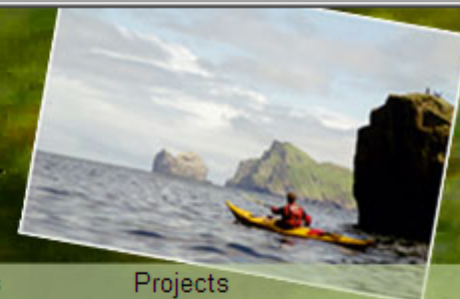


REMINDER

Scottish partners participating in the INTERREG funded Nature Based Tourism project have taken receipt of a bench-mark report into Nature Based Tourist market characteristics. This report, for the first time, collates existing relevant information on the market characteristics of visitors taking part in nature based tourism in the Highlands and Islands of Scotland. The findings of the report will be merged with similar pieces of commissioned work from Norway, Sweden and Iceland to provide the first comprehensive joined-up understanding of Nature Based Tourism in the Northern Periphery area.

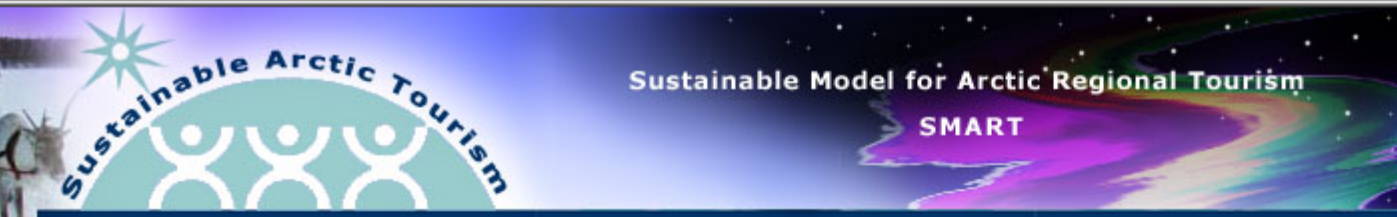
